Page 12, line 37, at end insert –

“(4A) Any time limit specified under subsection (4)(b) must be reasonable in the circumstances and must, in any event, be no less than three working days.”

Page 16, line 21, leave out from beginning to “does” in line 23 and insert “The Secretary of State may decide that any day falling within the period beginning with any day after the time limit referred to in subsection (2)(b) and ending with the day on which a notice under subsection (3)(a) is given”
