AMENDMENTS PROPOSED TO BE MADE IN THE OPPOSED BILL COMMITTEE, HOUSE OF LORDS

Explanatory Memorandum

Page 2, first paragraph (“Subsection (8)”), line 4, delete “destroy” and insert “dispose of”

Page 2, third paragraph (“Clause 5”), line 3, delete “improve” and insert “conserving”

Page 2, third paragraph (“Clause 5”), line 4, delete “The power may only be exercised in respect of graves where burial rights have been extinguished under *clause 4*, or where the grave is a public or common grave where no right of burial was granted provided it is not a protected grave pursuant to *clause 6(3)*.” and substitute “The power may only be exercised in respect of graves where no burial rights exist, either because the right has been extinguished under *clause 4*, because the right has expired or because the grave is a public or common grave where no right of burial was granted.”

Page 2, third paragraph (“Clause 5”), line 10, for “provides” substitute “provide”

Page 2, fourth paragraph (“Subsections (5) to (8)”), line 3, delete “tombstone” and insert “memorial”

Page 3, delete third paragraph (“Clause 8”).

Page 3, fifth paragraph (“Subsection (4)”), line 1, delete “(4)” and insert “(3)”

Page 3, fifth paragraph (“Subsection (4)”), line 2, after “byelaw” insert “, and for such a person”

Page 3, from beginning of seventh paragraph (“Clause 10”) to end of ninth paragraph (“Subsection (3)”), delete and substitute –

“Clause 10 makes provision for the repeal of the London Cemetery Company Act 1836, the London Cemetery Company Act 1843 and the London Cemetery Company Act 1911 so far as they relate to the cemetery, on the basis that they are redundant because the Trust now operates, and is the registered proprietor of, the cemetery.

Subsection (2) provides that the London Cemetery Company shall cease to be a body corporate and that all property, rights, liabilities, etc., of the London Cemetery Company shall pass to the Trust. This is necessary on the basis that the aforesaid Acts are proposed to be repealed. This provision is based on section 10 of the HBOS Group Reorganisation Act 2006 and section 3 of the St Austell Market Act 2008.

Subsection (3) provides that any act carried out by the London Cemetery Company which is required to be given effect insofar as related to the cemetery, shall be deemed to have effect as though the Trust carried out the act on the date on which the London Cemetery Company carried it out. This is substantially based on regulation 4 of the Infrastructure Act 2015 (Strategic Highways Companies) (Consequential, Transitional and Savings Provisions) Regulations 2015.”
