AMENDMENTS TO BE MOVED IN SPECIAL PUBLIC BILL COMMITTEE

Clause 3

LORD HODGSON OF ASTLEY ABBOTTS

Page 4, line 11, at end insert –

“(8A) Subsection (8) does not apply to an amendment which re-states the effect of the relevant provision or provisions as it was or they were prior to amendment.”

Member’s explanatory statement

This amendment provides that Charity Commission consent is not required for purely drafting amendments, which do not change the meaning of protected Clauses (Clauses of the kind described in proposed section 280A(8) of an unincorporated charity's governing document).

Page 4, line 34, at end insert –

“(1A) For the purposes of section 280A “amendment” includes the entire replacement of the trusts of the charity.”

Member’s explanatory statement

This amendment provides that the power of amendment in proposed section 280A can be used to replace the entire governing document of an unincorporated charity with a new governing document.
