**Schedule 1**

LORD LANSLEY

Page 6, line 21, leave out paragraph (b)

Page 6, line 22, at end insert –

“(3A) Before appointing an individual as a chair under sub-paragraph (3), the Secretary of State must provide information to the House of Commons Select Committee on Science and Technology about the intended appointment and make arrangements for that individual to appear before the committee if it so requests.”

Page 6, line 26, at end insert –

“(1A) Before appointing an individual as the first Chief Executive Officer under sub-paragraph (1), the Secretary of State must provide information to the House of Commons Select Committee on Science and Technology about the intended appointment and make arrangements for that individual to appear before the committee if it so requests.”

Page 10, line 24, at end insert “and other property”

Page 10, line 25, at end insert –

“(ca) acquire and license intellectual property,”

**Clause 2**

LORD LANSLEY

Page 2, line 3, at end insert –

“(ba) intellectual property may be vested in the Agency or shared with the beneficiaries of support;”

**Clause 2 - continued**

Page 2, line 15, at end insert –

- “(7) In exercising its functions, ARIA must have regard to any UK Research and Innovation Strategy in force at the time, and seek not to duplicate research funded by or through UKRI.”

**Clause 3**

LORD LANSLEY

Page 2, line 17, leave out from “may” to end of line 20 and insert “seek to support scientific research which has the potential to have transformational effects and large-scale benefits as set out in section 2(6), and to enable the development and exploitation of such research, taking into account the potential for the processes of discovery and inquiry to secure significant advances in technology.

- (2) Where the realisation of such benefits is uncertain but is expected significantly to exceed costs, ARIA must accept that the projects it supports may entail a high risk of failure.”

**Clause 4**

LORD LANSLEY

Page 2, line 23, at end insert –

- “(2A) The conditions may, in particular, include provision under which the revenue attributable to research supported by grants paid by the Secretary of State, including revenue acquired through the exploitation of the intellectual property derived from the research, is to be retained by ARIA and reinvested to support the exercise of its functions.”
