Member’s explanatory statement

This amendment would specifically include equity investment on the face of the Bill, as well as it being an example in the Illustrative Regulations and Guidance.

After Clause 9

LORD RAVENSDALE

4A★ Insert the following new Clause –

“The areas of disadvantage subsidy strategy

- (1) The areas of disadvantage subsidy strategy is a strategy made by regulations made by the Secretary of State which outlines how, in the opinion of the Secretary of State, subsidies should be used by public authorities to support the delivery of a strategy to increase investment in geographical areas of economic disadvantage within the United Kingdom.
- (2) Regulations under subsection (1) must make reference to either a map defining geographical areas which the Secretary of State considers to be at economic disadvantage, or a list of economic indicators with which areas of economic disadvantage can be identified.
- (3) Regulations under subsection (1) are subject to the affirmative procedure.
- (4) The Secretary of State must, within six months of this Act being passed, lay a draft of a statutory instrument containing regulations under subsection (1) before each House of Parliament for the purposes of making them in accordance with the affirmative procedure.”
