Page 1, line 4, at end insert –

- “(1A) The services and products to which subsection (1) applies include online or digital services or products that publish or place pornographic content on their service or product and operate any age assurance system.
- (1B) The Office of Communications (“Ofcom”) must create an outcomes-based regulatory framework which any age assurance system operated in relation to an online or digital service or product used by consumers or operated in the United Kingdom must meet, whether provided by artificial intelligence, self-declaration, capacity testing, account holder confirmation, biometric assessment or any other approach, in accordance with the criteria set out in section 2.”

Page 1, line 11, at end insert –

- “(1A) The standards in subsection (1) must set out the high-level principles to which regulated services must adhere when designing, procuring and operating any system of age assurance.”

Page 1, line 16, leave out paragraph (b) and insert –

- “(b) is proportionate to the risks posed to children by that service, including risks to life, risks of physical and emotional harm, and risks of economic exploitation and others as set out by Ofcom, having regard to the specific risks arising from the product or service;”
