Member's explanatory statement

Page 68, line 31, leave out subsection (6)

Member's explanatory statement

This is a tidying up amendment. This subsection disappplied a Clause of the bill (Clause 64 at Lords Report Stage) to children. However that Clause was then removed and replaced by a subsequent amendment. This amendment corrects this Clause for the updated version of the bill.
