LORDS AMENDMENT 4

**Baroness D’Souza to move, That this House do not insist on its Amendment 4, and do agree with the Commons in their Amendments 4A to 4F in lieu, and do propose the following amendment to the words so restored to the Bill –**

Page 12, line 13, leave out subsections (5) to (7)

**After Clause 37**

LORDS AMENDMENT 12

**Lord Alton of Liverpool to move, That this House do not insist on its Amendment 12, to which the Commons have disagreed for their Reason 12A, and do propose the following amendment in lieu –**

After Clause 37, insert the following new Clause –

**“Cases of genocide and the United Kingdom’s asylum and immigration systems**

Within a year of the date on which this Act is passed, the Secretary of State must publish a report on the Government’s approach to the treatment of victims of genocide as implemented through the United Kingdom’s asylum and immigration systems; and publish a comprehensive policy on the Government’s response to the duties contained in the 1948 Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide, as they relate to the United Kingdom’s asylum and immigration systems.”
