After Clause 208

After Clause 208, insert the following new Clause —

“Abortion: requirement for in-person consultation if the pregnant woman or girl is under the age of 18

After section 1(3D) of the Abortion Act 1967 (medical termination of pregnancy) insert —

“(3E) If the pregnant woman or girl is under the age of 18, any consultation must take place in person.””

Member's explanatory statement

This amendment seeks to ensure that a pregnant woman or girl under 18 years old would need to have an in-person consultation before they could be prescribed drugs to end a pregnancy, so that potential safeguarding needs are identified.
