LORDS AMENDMENT 2

Clause 4

Lord Hanson of Flint to move, That this House do not insist on its Amendment 2H to Commons Amendment 2F and its Amendment 2J to Commons Amendment 2G, and do agree with the Commons in their Amendment 2K to Commons Amendment 2F and Amendment 2L to Commons Amendment 2G in lieu.

LORDS AMENDMENTS 359 AND 439

After Clause 190

Lord Hanson of Flint to move, That this House do not insist on its Amendments 439E and 439F and do agree with the Commons in their Amendments 439C and 439D.

Lord Davies of Gower to move, as an amendment to the Minister's motion, leave out from “House” to the end and insert “do insist on its Amendments 439E and 439F and do insist on its disagreement with the Commons in their Amendments 439C and 439D.”
